Interior Design brings together form, function, productivity and psychology to change the way we experience our space. Interior designers influence the way we live, work and play. Through research and analysis students learn the fundamentals of the design process.

The KCAD Interior Design program has been continuously accredited by CIDA (formerly FIDER) since 1974. This rich history of accomplishment and accreditation serves as a framework for the comprehensive curriculum offered to today's students. Students in this program are eligible to participate in the IDFX, the first part of the three-section NCIDQ exam, the mark of a professional Interior Designer.

With a focus on design thinking, students will have the opportunity to collaborate with other students across disciplines, as well as industry and community partners. By working with students from many different programs, ideas are generated and design solutions are proposed to identify and tackle today's "wicked problems."

With strong ties to professional organizations such as IIDA and IDEC, students are encouraged to participate in both regional and national design competitions. Recent winners include a top ten candidate in the Interiors and Sources I Like Design competition, honorable mention in the ThinkUp! Design Competition, first place in the IIDA Booth Design Competition, and multiple winners in the IIDA MI Dr. Virginia North Student Competition.

Indemnification

To the extent permitted by law, Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University and Grand Rapids Community College agree to indemnify and hold one another harmless from any and all claims initiated by student participants, their parents, survivors, or agents, arising from any negligent acts or omission on the part of either institution or any of their employees.

Articulation Agreement

Effective Dates: 2/26/18– 08/15/20

This Agreement shall commence as of February 26, 2018 and shall be for an initial term of three years. Minor updates to the agreement may be made during this time. This agreement may be renewed at the end of three years. Either party may terminate this agreement by providing the other party with written notice of the intent to terminate the agreement. The agreement shall terminate not less than one hundred eighty (180) days from the date of the termination notice, unless otherwise agreed in writing by both parties.

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the transition of students from Grand Rapids Community College Workforce Development Program to Kendall College of Art and Design. Program is offered through the Grand Rapids Community College Workforce Development Program.

Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University will award articulated credit to students for the Workforce Development Program according to the condition/requirements as outlined in this agreement. Articulated Credit applies to degrees and certificates. This agreement is valid until August 15, 2020.
